The meeting will take place at the Institute for Cultural Anthropology and European Ethnology, Rheinsprung 9/11, 4051 Basel, Switzerland.

Registration will be open from April 1st.

The fees will be 150 CHF for non-SIEF members and 120 CHF for SIEF members. This includes 2 lunches, 2 dinners and all coffee breaks, as well as social events.
